






Origami: Samurai Helmet



Fold the paper in half diagonally to make a triangle.







Turn the paper so that the fold is at the top.


Fold the two outer corners of the triangle into the center point.




Fold each flap in half by taking the bottom point and folding it up to touch the top point.




Fold the inner corners of the flaps outwards so that the top point of each flap sticks out to the side.




Take the top sheet from the bottom half of your helmet and fold it up about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way. Be sure to keep the top point lined up with the center.




Take the very bottom of that same layer and fold it up to create a rim. The edges of the rim should line up with rest of your helmet.




Flip your helmet over.




Fold the flap upwards so that its point lines up with the top point of your helmet.



Unfold the crease you just made.



Tuck the fold inside helmet.



Turn the paper over and decorate your helmet with a personal symbol.
